NOTICE TO CONTRIBUTORS

Manuscripts should be sent to the Editor, McWilson Warren, 3088 Briarcliff Road, Suite A1, Atlanta, Georgia 30329, USA. Queries concerning reprints should be addressed to Allen Press, Inc., 1041 New Hampshire Street, Lawrence, Kansas 66044, USA.

*Manuscripts* should be typewritten, letter quality, in English in 10 pitch type, on one side of the paper and submitted in quadruplicate. Paper should be 8½ × 11 inches, pages should be numbered, and manuscript should be neither stapled nor folded. *Double spacing* should be used throughout the manuscript including in the list of references, tables, footnotes, and figure legends. Tabular or other material that has been reduced by xeroxing is not acceptable.

The following should be supplied: (a) a short title of not more than 50 letters for use as a running head; (b) the full title; (c) authors' names and affiliations; (d) footnotes; (e) address, telephone and fax numbers of corresponding author; (f) a concise, informative abstract; (g) list of the references cited; and (h) legends for the illustrations.

*Tables* should be typed each on a separate sheet and numbered serially in Arabic numerals. They should be designed for printing in 1-column width if possible, and should never require more than full-page width.

*Illustrations.* Graphs, drawings, and photographs illustrating specific points should be numbered and each should be cited in the text. Only glossy photographic prints or drawings in black India ink on white drawing paper or tracing linen can be used. One of the four sets of illustrations should be unmounted. Color illustrations are costly and can be reproduced only at the expense of the author. Material for illustrations should be protected with cardboard; the back of each should bear the figure number, name of senior author, and an arrow indicating the top of the figure. Legends should be separate and not attached to or written on the illustrations.

*References* should be cited by consecutive numbers in the text. The numbers should not be enclosed in parentheses and should appear after any closing punctuation. The reference listing at the end of the article should be consecutive. Abbreviate journal names in the style used by the National Library of Medicine. Any unpublished references should be listed in the text as "unpublished data" [include full name and affiliation of persons other than the authors] and not in the references.

Proprietary names of drugs or chemicals may be used in conjunction with the generic name when the substance is first mentioned in the abstract and in the body of the article. The generic name should be used elsewhere.

Symbols and common abbreviations should conform to the *CBE Style Manual*; the inventing of abbreviations is not encouraged—if thought essential their meaning should be spelled out at first mention.
